## Curriculum Overview

**Subject: History** 

Year Group: 7



In Year 7 the focus is on Medieval History. Pupils study a range of topics as they develop their Historical Skills. The topics include Roman Britain, Britain from 1066-Magna Carta, Trade, The Black Death, Renaissance, Reformation and the Age of Discovery.

Pupils will begin to develop their historical skills depending on their ability. This is based on their skills flight path. These skills include knowledge, chronology, cause/consequence, significance, ranking and justifying, LSESP, supported opinion.
